Yashwant was the son of an old-time actor named Datta Mahadik alias Master Chote and his wife Vatsalabai. Yashwant stepped on to the stage in 1969 in the play named 'Adich Ghare Vajirala'.

He earned greater fame by his performance in Madhusudan Kalelkar's, 'Nath Ha Maza'. Later, he won the audiences by his legendary title role in 'Nat Samrat'.

In addition to his screen performances Yashwant Datt is remembered for his plays 'Gaganbhedi', 'Vadal Manslay', 'Rajsanyas', 'Sonchapha', 'Kalchakra' and 'Premachya Gawa jave'. Yashwant was an artist with good voice, height and personality.
